- Stats: Femicide is on the rise in South Africa, with the Mail and Guardian reporting that 51% of women in SA say they've experienced GBV, with 76% of men saying they've perpetrated GBV at one stage in their lives (2010 Gauteng sample)
- EPF decided to host a Gender Based Violence Hackathon to address this challenge from the root cause: The perpetrators
- 60 developers were selected from a pool of 111 applicants, to join the third Hybrid hackathon that took place at the EPF Headquarters in Illovo, Sandton!
