

- EPF and Younglings partnered to host EPF's 21st hackathon.
- Funded by the EPF Tech Fund, the virtual Education Hackathon was hosted on Discord (online platform).
- Context: A contributing factor to the low student enrolment numbers in STEM subjects (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) is attributed to the quality of teaching in these disciplines.
- Hackathon challenge focus: How can technology assist Educators in delivering their STEM lessons more impactfully so that it leads to an increase in the number of student enrolments on STEM subjects?
- 300 young digital innovators from across South Africa in various fields of study such as programming developed tech solutions to solve the challenge.
- The winning team 'Full Stack Squad', who were awarded R14 000 in prize money, will join the EPF Incubation Hub where they will receive support to become tech-preneurs.





Guest Speaker Alwyn Van Wyk, Founder of Younglings. speaks to youth logged into Discord as they listen in live.







Screenshot of the last team, to present their solution to the judges, 'The Rubix Cube', on the Discord platform.





- Congratulations to Caps Off and Python Demonds who were placed 2nd and 3rd respectively.
